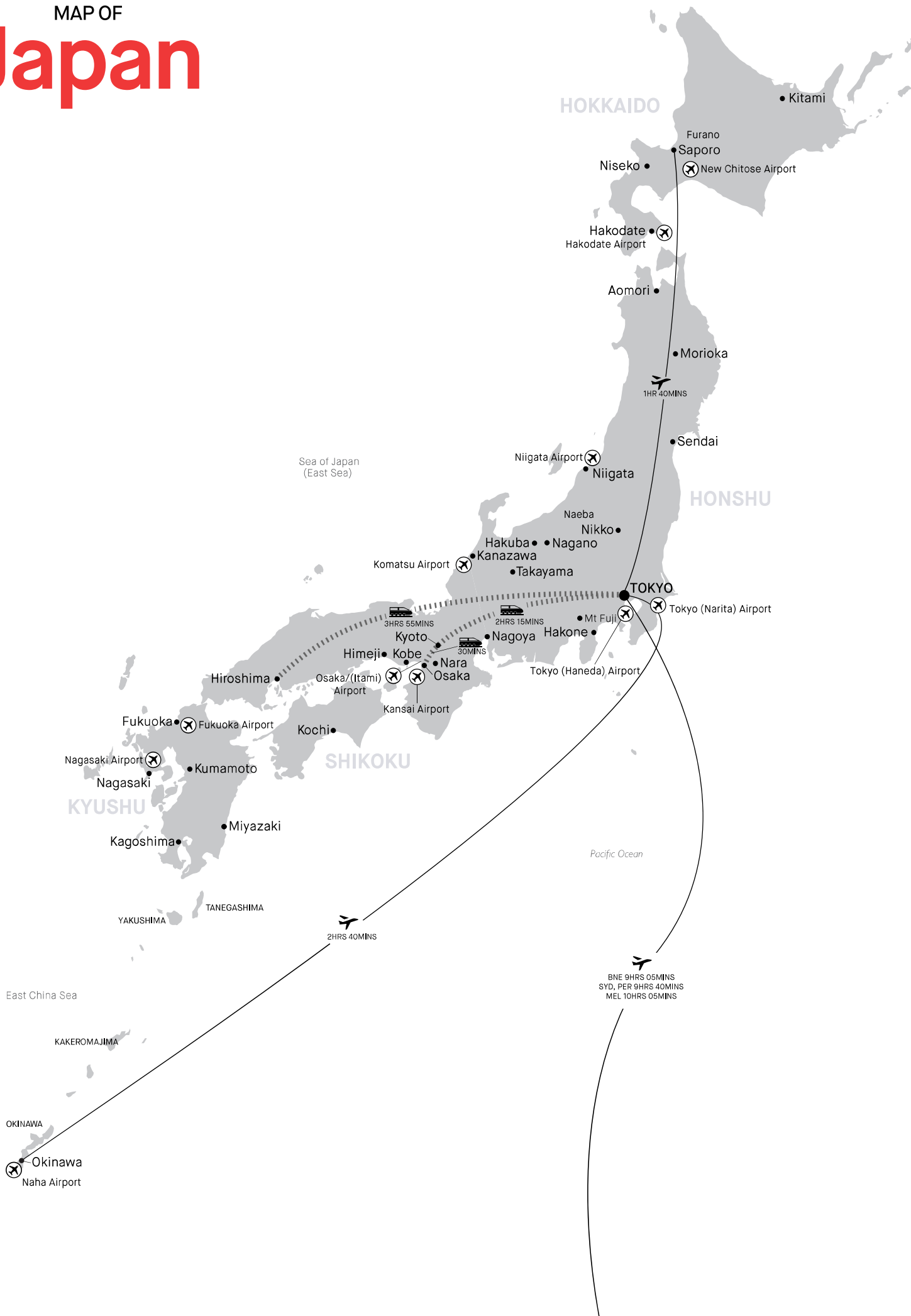

# Before you go



## Visa Information

**Australian Passport Holders** – Do not require pre-prescribed visas. You will be issued with a visitors entry permit valid for stays up to 90 days upon arrival in Japan, provided you have proof of ongoing travel and have at least 6 months of validity on your passport from the date of return into Australia.

**Other passport holders** – Please contact your department of foreign affairs or the consulate of Japan to check your specific visa requirements, if any.



## Health Information

Whilst Japan is a first world country that has a very high standard of healthcare available, please consider your physical and mental health before travelling to Japan. The Australian Government and JTB Australia recommend that you consult your local health care professional at least 8 weeks before you depart for Japan for a check-up and to get the most up to date information on any applicable vaccinations or current state of affairs specific to your health.



## Travel Insurance

### Winter in Japan is from December to February.

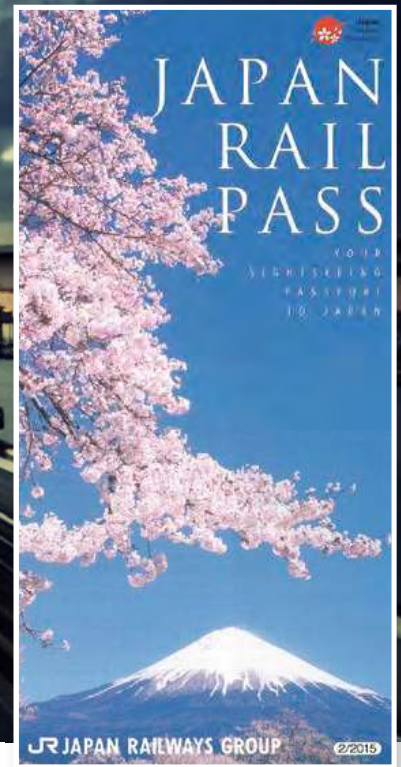

## Your key to convenient sightseeing in Japan!

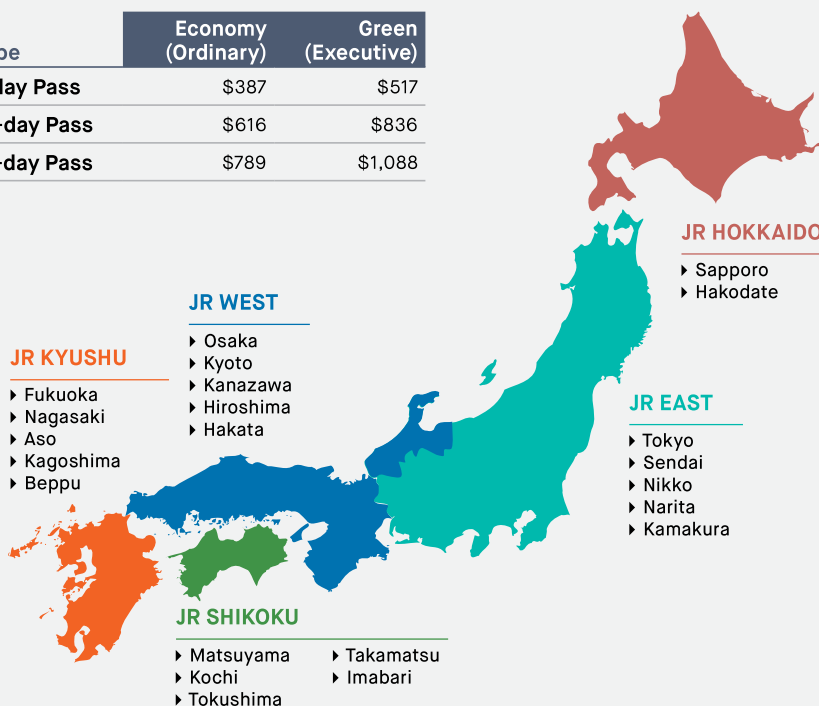

Japan Rail Passes are only available to travellers visiting Japan with a tourist (temporary visitor) visas. They are not available for working holiday or student visa holders. The trains are comfortable, clean and easy to ride so sit back, relax and enjoy Japan as you glide across the country.

This pass covers the entire Japan Railway JR system including some buses and a ferry. You are able to travel everywhere in Japan using this pass. Choose between 7, 14 and 21 consecutive day passes. Each are available in Economy (Ordinary) and Green (Executive) Class.

### SUICA PRE-PAID IC TRAIN PASS

The Suica card is a prepaid e-money card and can be used on JR East lines, subways and other private lines within the Tokyo metropolitan area. Simply touch your Suica card at the ticket gate. In addition to the Tokyo area, your Suica card can be used for certain transportation systems in the Sendai, Niigata, Hokkaido, Tokai, West Japan and Kyushu areas. This card is pre loaded with YEN1500 and a YEN500 card fee which can be refunded in Japan. You can top up the card in Japan, if required.

You can also use this card for purchases at vending machines, coin lockers and at the convenience stores within train stations.

Rarely visited by foreign tourists, Hokkaido is a vast island of wild coastal cliffs, extensive marshlands and forested mountains, a wonderful resource for birds, plants, animals and photogenic natural scenery. Hokkaido is a must see for those wishing to visit untouched Japan.

### DAY 1: ARRIVE IN TOKYO

Fly in to Tokyo Narita airport today. Stay tonight at Haneda Tokyu Hotel, a 4 star western style hotel located inside of Haneda Airport.

### DAY 2: MONDAY, 15 JUNE (B, D)

At breakfast this morning in our hotel, meet with your Japanese Tour Manager, Mrs Mayumi Gray, as well as our other tour guests. After breakfast fly from Haneda Airport to Memanbetsu Airport on the northern Japanese island of Hokkaido where you will begin your tour of Lake Tofutsu, Koshimizu Primeval Flower Garden and Oshinkoshin Waterfall.

### DAY 3: TUESDAY, 16 JUNE (B, D)

Early breakfast then discover nature's treasures along Japan's World Heritage listed site, Shiretoko Peninsula, a mountainous wilderness protruding into the Sea of Okhotsk. Take a boat cruise close to Shiretoko's sheer rocky cliffs to observe colonies of sea birds including cormorants, gulls and Spectacled Guillemot and maybe even Brown Bear!

### DAY 4: WEDNESDAY, 17 JUNE (B, D)

Tour through forests, rolling farmlands and small rural towns as we drive to the coast to the Port of Abashiri. At the Abashiri Drift Ice Museum we meet the curator and discover how the sea freezes here in winter. Enjoy a wide screen theatre presentation of The Sea of Okhotsk in 4 Seasons. You will also visit Omusaro Primeval Flower Garden, a nature conservation project of Monbetsu city.

### DAY 5: THURSDAY, 18 JUNE (B, D)

Sarobetsu Wetland Garden is a wild flower conservation area located outside of Wakkanai city, in the southern part of Sarobetsu Plain, and is part of Rishiri Reibun Sarobetsu National Park. Visit Wakasanai Enchi Park Observation Deck where wooden paths about 1.5km of lead across the primeval garden.

### DAY 6: FRIDAY, 19 JUNE (B, D)

After breakfast we will join local naturalist Mr Nomura and take a ferry cross to Teuri Island. Located in the Sea of Japan 30 km west of Haboro Port in the Rumoi Sub-prefecture in Hokkaido, the island's cliff lined northwest coast serves as a breeding ground for common guillemot, Rhinoceros Auklet, Spectacled Guillemot, Japanese Cormorant, and Slaty-backed Gull. After World War II, Hokkaido began a land restoration project and reforestation. The island is now designated as part of the Shokanbetsu-Teuri-Yagishiri Quasi National Park for one of the must see places in Japan for nature lovers.



### DAY 7: SATURDAY, 20 JUNE (B, D)

Before breakfast we will take a Fisherman's boat cruise around Teuri Island, another wonderful opportunity to photograph more sea birds and seals. After your boat trip, visit Akaiwa Observatory, looking at nests of Rhinoceros Auklet, Spectacled Guillemot and Common Murre.

### DAY 8: SUNDAY, 21 JUNE (B, D)

After breakfast you will take a ferry back to the mainland port of Haboro then tour to Asahikawa. Enroute visit Ueno farm and flower garden which is listed as one of 12 beautiful flower garden in Hokkaido.

### DAY 9: MONDAY, 22 JUNE (B, D)

Today we visit Tenninkyo in Daisetsuzan National Park to see two waterfalls that are the highlight of this area. Here is a great opportunity to photograph the 270 metre Hagoromo Waterfall. Next destination is Asahidake, the tallest mountain in Hokkaido (2,290m) located in the Daisetsu Mountain Range.

### DAY 10: TUESDAY, 23 JUNE (B, D)

Tour through the multi coloured patchwork fields around Furano, famous for its lavender farms and seasonal flowers with millions of blooms destined for flower markets around Japan. Next head to Sapporo, capital city of Hokkaido. Enjoy free time to wander through the city centre's Odori Park with its fountains and flower filled gardens. Alternatively, you might like to go shopping in the underground shopping streets, go up Sapporo Tower for a birds eye view of Sapporo. Tonight we include an all included buffet dinner at the famous Sapporo Beer Hall.

### DAY 11: WEDNESDAY, 24 JUNE (B, D)

Tour along the shores of Uchiura Bay to Lake Onuma Quasi National Park with its majestic dormant volcano, Mount Komagatake. In the afternoon we will walk around the birch, oak, alder and maple forest trails to see placid scenes across the lakes, as well as do a little bird watching for Black Woodpeckers, Arctic Warbler and Mandarin Duck.

### DAY 12: THURSDAY, 25 JUNE (B, D)

Travel to historic Hakodate, one of the first cities in Japan open to foreigners after the Meiji Restoration. Hakodate has some of the most authentic and best preserved historic buildings in Japan. Enjoy sites such as the Motomachi area, the old Magistrate's Office, the Russian Byzantine Church, Catholic Church, Trappist Convent, Chinese Memorial Hall and the original Town Hall. Last visit today is to Mt Hakodate from where you can look down upon the twinkling lights that surround Hakodate Bay.

### DAY 13: FRIDAY, 26 JUNE (B)

Visit the Hakodate Morning Market where the freshest seafood and farm produce is available for sale before flying from Hakodate to Tokyo. After arriving in Tokyo you have free time for last minute shopping and sightseeing.

### DAY 14: SATURDAY, 27 JUNE (B)

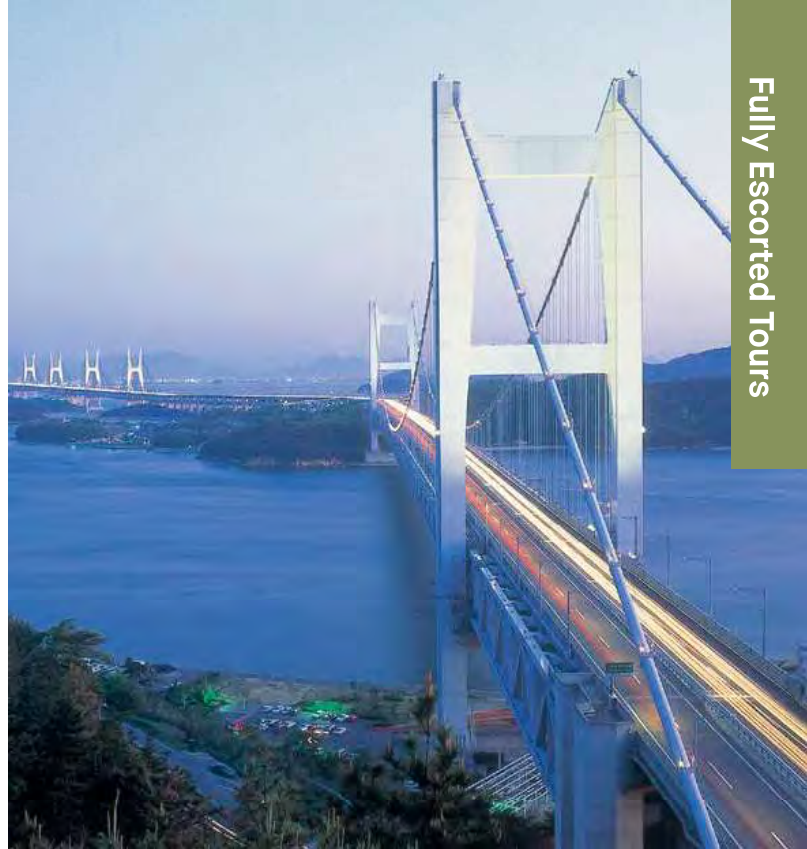
### DAY 4: TAKAMATSU – SHODOSHIMA ISLAND – TAKAMATSU (B)

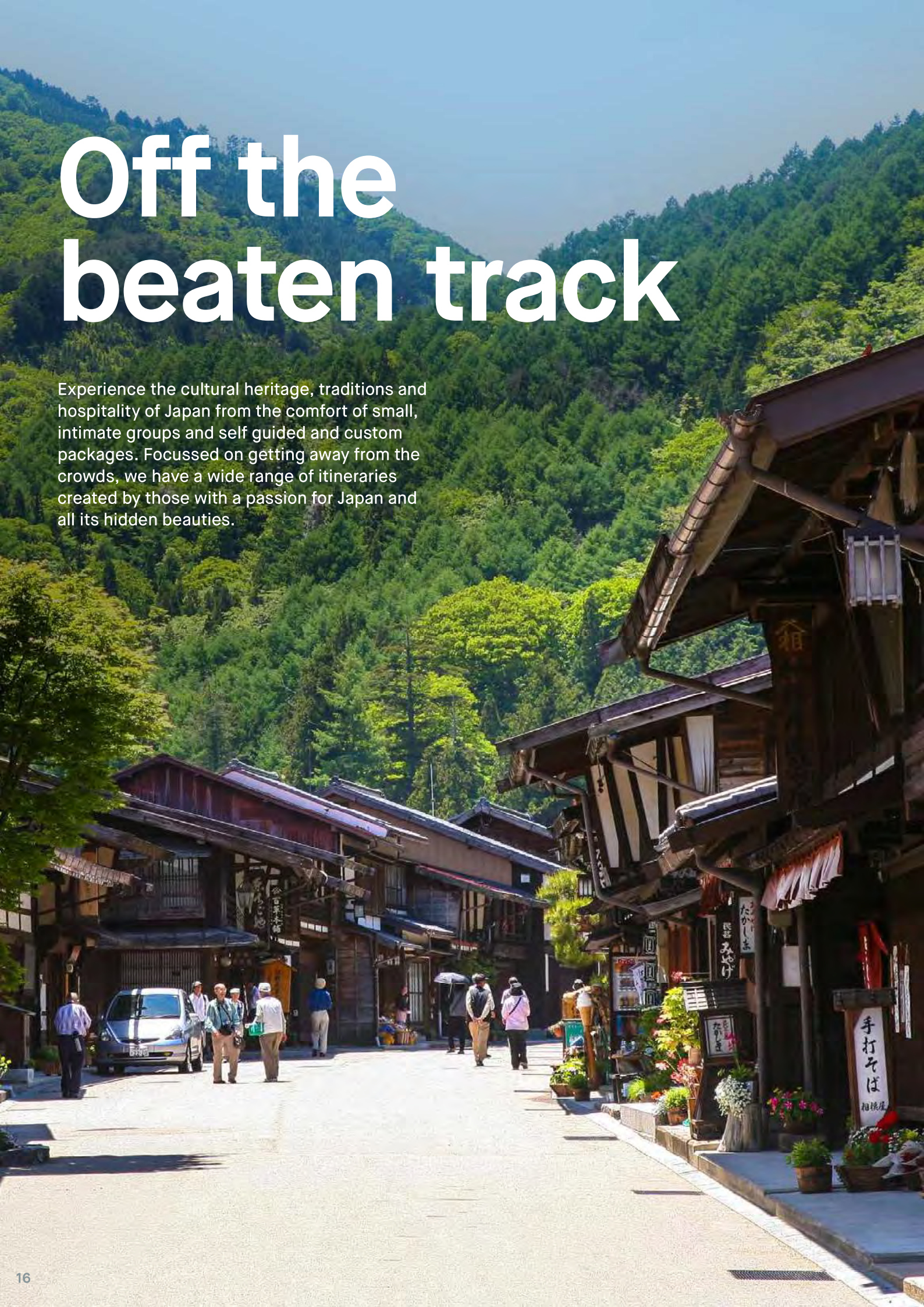

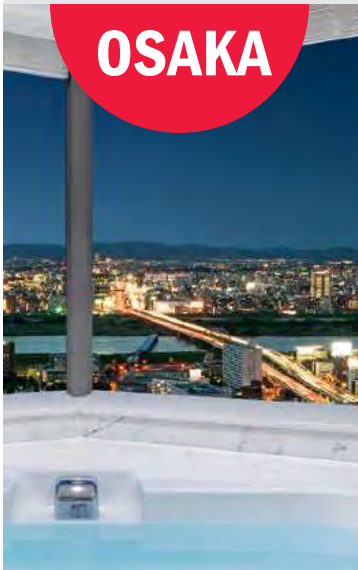

A long stone staircase, lined by monolithic cypress and cedar trees, leads to the sacred grounds of the Kumano Hongu Taisha. It is one of the Kumano Sanzan, three grand shrines of Kumano.

#### DAY 4: KII-KATSUURA – OSAKA (B)

Spend the morning exploring the seaside town of Kii-Katsuura or head back to the Kumano Kodo trail to further explore the fascinating shrines and temples such as Seiganto-ji.

##### Nachi Falls & Seiganto-ji temple

Part of a large religious complex, Nachi Taisha Shrine exemplifies the harmonious fusion of Shintoism and Buddhism. A highlight of the area is the picturesque three storied pagoda of Seiganto-ji temple, which overlooks Nachi Falls.

Japan is a chain of volcanic islands with natural hot springs found all over the country. Experiencing an onsen is a great way to immerse yourself in Japanese culture!

### Etiquette

Onsen, or hot springs, are deeply ingrained in Japanese society. For travellers, onsen can be one of the most confusing and confronting aspects of Japanese culture. To prepare you for your inauguration into Japanese onsen culture, you need to understand the code of conduct. Whilst it is not limited to these, please do not forget the following points;

1. Shower in the wash area before you enter the hot spring
2. Birthday suits only! Clothes forbidden
3. Never dip your hand towel in the water
4. Never put your head underwater
5. Be considerate of other bathers and keep noise to a minimum
6. Sit back, relax and let the healing waters refresh your mind, body and soul!

### Tattoos

In Japan tattoos are perceived as a sign of the membership to an organised crime syndicate, otherwise known as Yakuza. In general those with tattoos are not allowed to use public bath facilities. However, it is common practice for foreign visitors with small tattoos to cover them with an adhesive dressing when bathing. This is perfectly acceptable and shows respect for the culture and attitudes prevailing in Japan.
